**Kern County** (Delano/McFarland): **OFM** – Biofix 3/3, 411DD. **PTB** - Weak flight has begun. Biofix 4/1, 90DD. **CRS** – Flights have started in some area orchards but not yet at our site. **SJS** – Biofix 3/16, 230DD.

**OLR** – Biofix 3/12, 288DD. **NOW** – Only minor activity. Couple of eggs to date.

**Codling Moth Note** – Flight has begun. Some female moths trapped in Bakersfield area in DA baited traps.

<u>Tulare County</u> (NE Kingsburg area): **CM** – Visalia Walnuts – Biofix 3/23, 141DD. Kingsburg plums - No activity. **OFM** – Biofix 3/3, 324DD. **PTB** – Biofix 4/3, 37DD. **CRS** – Biofix 3/23, 103DD. **OLR** – Biofix 3/23, 151DD. **SJS** – Biofix 3/20, 144DD.

<u>Madera County:</u> **CM** – Biofix 4/6, 23DD. **OFM** - Biofix 3/7, 349DD. **PTB** – Biofix 4/2, 56DD. **OLR** – Biofix 3/7, 280DD. **NOW** – Biofix 4/6, 17DD.

<u>Merced County</u> (Ballico & Winton areas): **CM** – Biofix 3/28, 97DD. Low flight numbers. **OFM** – Biofix 2/25, 440DD. **PTB** - None trapped yet.

<u>Sacramento County</u> (Delta area): **CM** – Biofix 3/24, 150DD. No indication of female emergence yet, based on DA and CM-DA COMBO baited traps. **OFM** – Biofix 3/13, 337DD.

<u>Sutter County</u> (Yuba City): **CM** – Biofix 3/30,78DD. Low flight numbers. **OFM** – Biofix 2/25, 402DD. Strong flight. **PTB** - None trapped yet.

Butte County (Gridley): CM – No activity at our test orchard. OFM – Biofix 2/27, 374DD. PTB – None trapped.

NOTE: Mark you calendars for the dates listed below.

MARCH: CM, CM-DA COMBO, DA, CM 10X, CRS, DBM and PTB traps should be set.
