**Kern County** (Delano/McFarland): **OFM** – F2 Biofix (third flight) 6/14, 63DD. **PTB** - F1 Biofix 6/1, 343DD. **CRS** – 2<sup>nd</sup> flight Biofix 6/15, 62DD. Key trapping period now. **SJS** – Second Male flight (F1) Biofix 5/28, 434DD. **OLR** – F1 (second flight) Biofix 5/24, 589DD. **NOW** – Biofix 4/15, 966DD.

**Tulare County** (NE Kingsburg area): **CM** – Visalia Walnuts – F1 Biofix 6/3 (adjusted since last report), 295DD. Kingsburg plums – F1 Biofix 6/3, 264DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/13, 947DD. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/8, 176DD. **CRS** – F1 (second flight) biofix 6/10, 223DD. Second flight has started. **OLR** – F1 Biofix 5/30, 396DD. **SJS** – F1 Biofix 5/28, no DD update.

**Madera County:** **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/7, 180DD. **OFM** - F1 Biofix 5/13, 920DD. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/1, 309DD. Seeing shoot strikes in almonds. **OLR** – F1 Biofix 5/22, 580DD. **NOW** – Biofix 4/6, 940DD.

**Sutter County** (Yuba City): **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/11, 132DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/12, 317DD. Treating next week. **PTB** – Biofix 4/21, 1051DD.

**Butte County** (Gridley): **CM** – Biofix 4/20 at our test orchard. 1,015DD. Other orchards biofixed much earlier and degree-days are more similar to Sutter Co. Use data from your orchard. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/15, 796DD. **PTB** – First moth trapped 5/3. 855DD. Other orchards in area biofixed 1-2 weeks earlier.
