Kern County (Delano/McFarland): **OFM** – Biofix 3/8, 437DD. **PTB** – Biofix 4/2, 107DD. **CM** – Biofix 4/5. **CRS** – Biofix 3/31, 115DD. **SJS** – Biofix 3/18, 196DD. **OLR** - Biofix 3/16, 265DD. **NOW** – No activity in egg traps.

Tulare County (NE Kingsburg area except where noted): **OFM** – Biofix 3/9, 400DD. **PTB** – Biofix 4/11, 21DD. **CM** – (Tulare walnuts) Biofix 4/1, 128DD. **CRS** (Exeter) – Biofix 4/1, 94DD. **SJS** – Biofix 3/13,206DD.

Madera County: **CM** – No trap activity. **OFM** - Biofix 3/17, 283DD. **PTB** – No consistent catches. **OLR** - Biofix 3/10, 298DD.

Merced County (Ballico & Winton areas): **OFM** – Biofix 3/7, 340DD. **CM** – A few moths trapped. Biofix not set. **PTB** – No trap activity.

Sacramento County (Delta area): **OFM** – Biofix 3/14, 290DD. **CM** – Very little trap activity in orchards that used Mating Disruption in 2010. Some activity in non-disrupted orchards during warm weather of 3/31-4/1. No female moths have emerged.

Yuba County (Marysville): **OFM** – Biofix 3/8, 328DD. **CM** – Very little trap activity in orchards that used Mating Disruption in 2010. Some activity in non-disrupted orchards during warm weather of 3/31-4/1. No female moths have emerged.

Butte County (Gridley): **OFM** – First moths trapped 3/8, 310DD. **CM** – No trap activity. **PTB** – No trap activity.
