This is our first IPM Partner Field Reporter for 2015 representing our 19th year of publication. As last season, you can now expect to receive bi-monthly reports through August, 2015. We will appreciate comments or suggestions you might have on this report.

The counties that will be reporting this season are as follows:

- Kern County – Delano / McFarland Area: A few OFM have been trapped already (2/12-15)
- Madera County – Madera Co., East of Madera
- Merced County – Ballico & Winton Areas
- Tulare County – NE Kingsburg Area
- Sacramento County – Delta Area
- Yuba County – Marysville

The Field Reporter, provided bi-monthly, will be “site specific” information regarding trapping, biofix and degree day information for certain insects. This information is supplied by Trece, Inc., as a guide to the timing of spray applications and other pest management operations for certain insects. The material should be regarded as a supplementary aid in insect control planning. Pest Control Advisors shall themselves determine trapping, biofix and degree day information for individual orchards for site specific information.

NOTE: Mark you calendars for the dates listed below.

FEBRUARY: OFM, OLR and SJS traps should be set.

MARCH: CM, CM-DA COMBO, DA, CM 10X, CRS, DBM AND PTB traps should be set.
