You can now expect to receive bi-monthly reports through August, as with last season, that cover base minimum facts about the degree day accumulation by county for each insect. We will appreciate your comments and suggestions.

This year we are expanding the Field Reporter to provide coverage of up to six insects and additional areas. The counties that will be reporting this season are as follows:

- FEBRUARY:** OFM, OLR and SJS traps should be set.
